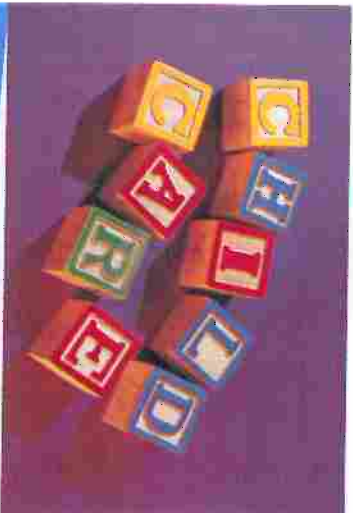


Resource Teaching Program



Who is eligible for our service?

- The Resource Teaching Program offers services to children who are experiencing challenges in one or more of the following areas of development: physical, social, emotional, communication, intellectual, behavioral and/or has increased environmental stresses including those related to family, social, economical or cultural circumstances.
- Children range in age from birth to twelve years of age.
- Families must have their child enrolled or wish to have them participate in a licensed childcare setting in Lennox & Addington County.
- Licensed childcare settings include: Day Care Centers, School-age Programs, Licensed Home Child Care and LARC Early Years Playgroups.



What services can we provide to families?

- Assisting families in obtaining assessments or testing as needed.
- Provide Consultation to develop goals, strategies and implement recommendations.
- Assist parents in choosing an appropriate child care setting.
- Fostering and promoting inclusion in a community child care setting.
- Connecting families to coordinate and access funding such as ACSD & SSAH.
- Assist with the transition to preschool and later elementary school.
- Consultation with school
- Attend or organize case conferences, as needed.
- Act as a liaison with the childcare setting to consult, provide resources and ensure inclusion.
- Work with you and the child care staff to develop and individual goal plan for your child.

What services can we provide to licensed childcare providers?

- On site consultation and regular visitation from a Resource Consultant.
- Provision of adaptive equipment.
- Lending of teaching aids, games, toys and activities to enhance the program.
- Development of individual program plans & goals with input from child care staff and the family.
- Ongoing support and review of the goals to ensure they are meeting the needs of the child.
- Opportunities for training as it relates to providing an inclusive setting.
- Loan of books from the resource library at LARC.
- Funding for enhanced staffing to foster and promote inclusion.
